## AI-Assisted Open Source Intelligence Assessment

Analysis Period: April 21, 2026 - April 28, 2026

## Executive Summary

During the period of April 21-28, 2026, Cambodia's security landscape was primarily shaped by significant diplomatic engagements and intensified efforts against cybercrime. The nation hosted the inaugural "2+2" Strategic Dialogue with China, signaling a deepening of military and political cooperation, including Chinese support for Cambodia's military modernization and an agreement to expand the dialogue to a "3+3" mechanism to include public security. Concurrently, Cambodia continued its nationwide crackdown on online scam operations, leading to the closure of numerous casinos and the deportation of thousands of foreign nationals, a move that aligns with international pressure, including sanctions from the United States. A notable development in maritime security saw Thailand moving to revoke a long-standing bilateral memorandum of understanding concerning overlapping sea claims, prompting Cambodia to increasingly rely on the UN Convention on the Law of the Sea (UNCLOS) as a legal safeguard. These developments highlight Cambodia's complex balancing act in its foreign relations and its commitment to addressing internal security threats.

## Key Security Developments

- **Deepening Cambodia-China Strategic Dialogue:** On April 22, 2026, Cambodia and China held their first "2+2" Strategic Dialogue in Phnom Penh, bringing together their respective foreign and defense ministers. This meeting, co-chaired by Cambodian Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs Prak Sokhonn and Minister of National Defence Tea Seiha, and Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi and Defense Minister Dong Jun, aimed to deepen political and security trust and advance their comprehensive strategic partnership.
- **Expansion of China-Cambodia Security Mechanism:** During the "2+2" dialogue on April 22, both nations agreed to upgrade the mechanism to a "3+3" format. This expansion will include the Cambodian Ministry of Interior and the Chinese Ministry of Public Security, signifying a broader scope of cooperation in law enforcement and public security matters.
- **China's Support for Military Modernization:** Chinese Defence Minister Dong Jun reiterated China's support for Cambodia's military modernization efforts across maritime, land, and air domains during the "2+2" dialogue. This commitment reinforces the "ironclad friendship" between the two countries and aims to strengthen Cambodia's defense capabilities.

- **Intensified Crackdown on Online Scams:** Cambodia continued its nationwide crackdown on cybercrime networks, ordering the closure of 91 casinos linked to online scam operations and raiding over 250 suspected scam centers over the past nine months. From mid-January to April 19, 2026, 13,039 foreign nationals involved in online scams were deported, and 241,888 individuals voluntarily departed Cambodia. This crackdown is in line with a new law on combating online scams that came into force on April 6, introducing tougher penalties.
- **US Sanctions on Cambodian Senator for Cyberscams:** On April 27, 2026, the U.S. Treasury Department sanctioned a prominent Cambodian lawmaker, Senator Kok An, and 28 other individuals and companies for operating cyberscam networks from Cambodia. This action is part of a broader U.S. crackdown on Southeast Asian cyberscam operations, with U.S. Attorney Jeanine Pirro characterizing it as a "new theater of war" against Chinese transnational organized crime.
- **Thailand's Revocation of Maritime MoU:** Thailand's National Security Council, chaired by Prime Minister Anutin Charnvirakul, resolved on April 23, 2026, to terminate the 2001 maritime Memorandum of Understanding (MoU44) with Cambodia. This decision, which will be sent to the cabinet for final approval, cites a lack of progress in negotiations over overlapping sea claims in the Gulf of Thailand after more than two decades.
- **Cambodia's Reliance on UNCLOS for Maritime Rights:** In response to Thailand's move to revoke MoU44, Cambodia is increasingly relying on the UN Convention on the Law of the Sea (UNCLOS) as a legal safeguard for its maritime rights. Cambodia formally ratified UNCLOS on January 16, 2026, with accession taking effect on March 8, 2026, making it the 172nd State Party.
- **Informal Cambodia-Thailand Border Meeting:** On April 23, 2026, the Cambodian Military Region 4 and Thai Army Area 2 held an informal meeting of the Secretariat of the Cambodia-Thailand Regional Border Committee (RBC) at the Choam-Sa Ngam International Border Checkpoint in Oddar Meanchey Province. This meeting occurred amidst ongoing border tensions and Thailand's decision regarding MoU44.
- **Upcoming Military Conscription:** Cambodia is set to implement its long-dormant military conscription law starting in 2026, with Prime Minister Hun Manet announcing an extension of the service period from 18 to 24 months. This move is aimed at modernizing the armed forces and addressing personnel shortages, partly in response to rising tensions with Thailand.
- **Resumption of "Angkor Sentinel" with US:** Cambodia and the United States are set to resume their flagship joint military exercise, "Angkor Sentinel," in late 2026, marking a restoration of defense cooperation after an eight-year suspension. This indicates Cambodia's strategy of active neutrality and diversification of security dependencies.

## Geopolitical Impact and Regional Dynamics

Cambodia's security developments this past week underscore its complex and evolving geopolitical position, particularly in balancing relations with major powers and managing regional disputes. The inaugural "2+2" Strategic Dialogue with China on April 22, 2026, and the subsequent agreement to upgrade it to a "3+3" mechanism, signifies a deepening of the "ironclad friendship" and comprehensive strategic partnership between Phnom Penh and Beijing. This enhanced cooperation, including China's support for Cambodia's military modernization, solidifies China's influence in the region and within Cambodia's defense posture. Such close ties with China, Cambodia's largest investor and aid donor, may be viewed with apprehension by some Western nations, particularly the United States, which has expressed concerns about the potential for Chinese military use of facilities like the Ream Naval Base.

Simultaneously, Cambodia is attempting to balance its foreign policy by resuming the "Angkor Sentinel" joint military exercise with the United States in late 2026. This move suggests a strategy of "active neutrality" aimed at professionalizing its forces through Western standards while diversifying its security dependencies. The recent signing of a bilateral health MOU with the US on April 2, 2026, further indicates ongoing engagement with Washington, despite the strong ties with Beijing. These dual engagements highlight Cambodia's pragmatic approach to international relations, seeking benefits from both major powers while navigating regional rivalries.

The decision by Thailand to revoke the 2001 maritime MoU (MoU44) with Cambodia introduces a new layer of complexity to regional stability. This move, driven by a lack of progress in resolving overlapping sea claims, could escalate tensions in the Gulf of Thailand, particularly concerning potential offshore oil and gas resources. Cambodia's increased reliance on UNCLOS as a legal framework for its maritime rights signals a shift towards international law in resolving disputes, which could either provide a clearer path for negotiation or lead to prolonged legal battles. The ongoing crackdown on cyber scam operations, including US sanctions against a Cambodian senator, also reflects international pressure on Cambodia to address transnational crime, which has implications for its international reputation and relations with countries like the US.

## Military and Defense Analysis

Cambodia's military and defense posture is undergoing significant shifts, driven by both internal modernization goals and external geopolitical dynamics. The recent "2+2" Strategic Dialogue with China on April 22, 2026, underscored China's

commitment to supporting Cambodia's military modernization across its maritime, land, and air capabilities. This support is crucial for the Royal Cambodian Armed Forces (RCAF) as it seeks to enhance its operational readiness and technical expertise. The acquisition of new naval assets, such as the Type 056C corvette provided by China, and the ongoing modernization of Ream Naval Base, are key components of this development, significantly boosting the Kingdom's maritime defense capabilities.

In a notable development, Prime Minister Hun Manet announced that Cambodia will implement its long-dormant military conscription law starting in 2026, extending the service period from 18 to 24 months. This measure aims to address personnel shortages due to retirement and to strengthen national defense, partly in response to rising border tensions with Thailand. The RCAF is also actively recruiting 3,000 more soldiers to bolster ground forces. Concurrently, Cambodia is balancing its defense partnerships by resuming the "Angkor Sentinel" joint military exercise with the United States in late 2026. This exercise, which focuses on improving joint training and operational readiness, reflects Cambodia's strategy to professionalize its forces through Western standards of interoperability while diversifying its security dependencies. Defense spending is also on an upward trend, with Cambodia approving a record draft national budget for 2026 exceeding \$10 billion, a 7.8% increase from 2025, with a greater focus on the defense sector.

## Outlook and Forecast

Short-term trends (1-3 months): In the immediate future, Cambodia will likely continue its aggressive crackdown on online scam operations, aiming to meet its self-imposed deadline of eliminating them by the end of April 2026. This will involve further raids, casino closures, and deportations, potentially leading to a temporary decrease in such activities but also raising concerns about human rights and the potential for operations to simply relocate. The diplomatic fallout from Thailand's decision to revoke MoU44 will likely intensify, with Cambodia actively pursuing its maritime claims through UNCLOS. This could lead to increased rhetoric and diplomatic maneuvering between Phnom Penh and Bangkok. The enhanced "3+3" strategic dialogue with China will likely see initial steps towards deeper cooperation in law enforcement and public security, with potential for joint operations or intelligence sharing related to cybercrime and other transnational issues.

Critical flashpoints and risk areas:

- Cambodia-Thailand Maritime Border: The revocation of MoU44 by Thailand creates a significant flashpoint in the Gulf of Thailand. Disputed areas, particularly those with potential oil and gas reserves, could become areas of increased tension

or even minor naval confrontations if not managed carefully through international legal frameworks.

- **Cybercrime and Human Trafficking:** While Cambodia is cracking down on scams, the underlying criminal networks are deeply entrenched. The risk remains that these operations could re-emerge or shift tactics, potentially leading to further international pressure and sanctions. The human trafficking aspect associated with these scams continues to be a critical humanitarian and security concern.
- **Ream Naval Base:** The ongoing modernization of Ream Naval Base with Chinese assistance remains a point of contention, particularly with the United States. Any perceived increase in Chinese military presence or access could heighten regional anxieties and further strain Cambodia-US relations.

Indicators to monitor:

- **Effectiveness of Anti-Scam Crackdown:** Monitor the number of successful prosecutions, the long-term closure of scam centers, and the repatriation efforts for victims.
- **Cambodia-Thailand Maritime Negotiations:** Observe any new bilateral or multilateral initiatives to resolve the maritime dispute, and how both nations leverage UNCLOS.
- **Scope of China-Cambodia "3+3" Cooperation:** Look for specific details on joint law enforcement operations, cybersecurity initiatives, or intelligence sharing under the expanded dialogue.
- **Progress of "Angkor Sentinel" Exercise:** The successful resumption and scale of the joint military exercise with the US will indicate the extent of Cambodia's balancing act.
- **Defense Spending and Conscription Implementation:** Track the actual increase in defense budget allocation and the smooth implementation of the military conscription law.

Strategic recommendations:

Cambodia should prioritize transparent communication regarding its anti-scam efforts to rebuild international trust and mitigate the risk of further sanctions. In the maritime dispute with Thailand, Cambodia should actively engage in dialogue under the UNCLOS framework, seeking peaceful resolution and avoiding any unilateral actions that could escalate tensions. Diversifying defense partnerships, as indicated by the resumption of "Angkor Sentinel" with the US, should be strategically maintained to avoid over-reliance on any single major power. Internally, the government should ensure that the military conscription is implemented fairly and effectively, contributing to national defense without unduly burdening its citizens. Furthermore, Cambodia should continue to strengthen its cybersecurity infrastructure and legal frameworks to proactively combat evolving cyber threats beyond just scam

operations.
