## Executive Summary

During the period of April 22-29, 2026, Thailand's security landscape was characterized by a mix of persistent internal challenges, evolving border dynamics, and active diplomatic engagement aimed at bolstering national defense and regional stability. A significant cross-border incident occurred on April 20, when a Myanmar junta bomb landed in Thai territory, prompting heightened security measures along the Thai-Myanmar border. Concurrently, Thailand initiated steps to revoke a long-standing maritime MOU with Cambodia, signaling a shift in its approach to managing disputed sea areas, while also commencing border fence projects with both Cambodia and Malaysia. Diplomatic efforts saw high-level meetings with China and Singapore, focusing on strategic alignment, cybersecurity, and defense cooperation. Internally, the southern provinces continued to face insurgency, highlighted by a recent assassination attempt on an MP, and a localized bomb scare at Krabi Airport underscored the need for vigilance.

## Key Security Developments

- Military Activities and Exercises - Myanmar Border Security Beefed Up

Security was significantly stepped up in Mae Sariang district, Mae Hong Son province, following an incident on April 20 where a Myanmar junta fighter jet dropped a bomb in Thai territory while targeting a Karen National Union (KNU) military hospital in Myanmar's Hpapun district. This prompted Mae Sariang's district chief, Worasak Panthong, to order increased patrols, checkpoints, roadblocks, and the reinforcement of bomb shelters in vulnerable border villages. The incident highlighted the ongoing instability in Myanmar spilling over into Thai territory.

- Defense Policy and Strategic Shifts - Revocation of Maritime MOU with Cambodia

On April 23, Thai Prime Minister Anutin Charnvirakul announced that the National Security Council had confirmed the abolition of the 2001 maritime Memorandum of Understanding (MOU 44) with Cambodia, which concerned overlapping sea areas. The decision, reported on April 23, 24, and 28, was attributed to a lack of tangible progress over 25 years. Thailand intends to pursue maritime boundary negotiations with Cambodia under the framework of the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea (UNCLOS), which is considered a clearer and more widely accepted legal basis.

- Maritime and Border Security - Border Fence Projects Initiated

Prime Minister Anutin Charnvirakul stated on April 24 that Thailand has commenced border fence projects along both its Thai-Cambodian and Thai-Malaysian frontiers. These projects, with allocated budgets and assigned military units, aim to prevent the smuggling of illegal goods, illegal border crossings, and terrorism. The Royal Thai Navy will be responsible for the eastern border, while the Royal Thai Armed Forces Headquarters will oversee the line from Sa Kaeo and Prachin Buri through to Ubon Ratchathani, and the Fourth Army Region will manage the southern border.

- Defense Acquisitions and Arms Deals - Royal Thai Navy Frigate Procurement

The Royal Thai Navy (RTN) announced on April 22 that six international companies had submitted proposals for its frigate procurement project. The companies include Hyundai Heavy Industries Co (South Korea), Singapore Technologies Engineering Ltd (Singapore), Askeri Fabrika ve Tersane İşletmeleri AŞ (Turkey), TAIS Gemi İnşa ve Teknoloji AŞ (Turkey), Hanwha Ocean Co (South Korea), and Navantia SA (Spain). A detailed review of these proposals, covering technical, economic, and industrial offset aspects, is expected to take over one month.

- Defense Acquisitions and Arms Deals - Amphibious Armored Vehicle Introduction

On April 28, the Royal Thai Navy introduced new amphibious 8x8 armored vehicles, with approximately 40% of their components sourced domestically. These vehicles are designed to enhance border security, support emergency response, and protect sovereignty, operating in coordination with landing platform dock vessels. This acquisition is seen as a step forward in Thailand's defense industry development policy.

- Diplomatic Relations - China Visit and Cooperation

Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi visited Thailand on April 24, meeting with Prime Minister Anutin Charnvirakul. Both nations agreed to strengthen strategic alignment and enhance cooperation in various fields, including combating transnational crime and cyberscams. Wang Yi also expressed China's willingness to continue playing a constructive role in resolving the border conflict between Thailand and Cambodia.

- Diplomatic Relations - Singapore Defense Ties Strengthened

Thai Defence Minister Lt. Gen. Adul Boonthamcharoen met with Singaporean Defence Minister Chan Chun Sing in Bangkok on April 27. The two countries agreed to strengthen defense cooperation across several areas, including joint military exercises, defense industry development, cybersecurity, and critically, the protection of underwater infrastructure. This visit marked Minister Chan Chun Sing's first official trip to Thailand in his current role.

- Maritime and Border Security - Strait of Hormuz Concerns

Thailand's Permanent Representative to the UN, Ambassador Cherdchai Chaivaivid, addressed the UN Security Council on April 27, highlighting the risks to strategic

maritime chokepoints like the Strait of Hormuz. He emphasized that disruptions in such areas endanger seafarers, disrupt global energy flows, and have wider economic consequences. Thailand called for restraint and adherence to international law, having previously sought safe passage for its vessels amid regional instability.

- Security Incidents and Threats - Southern Insurgency and Assassination Attempt

Critics on April 28 warned that the military-led approach in Thailand's southern border provinces of Pattani, Yala, and Narathiwat may be prolonging unrest, with over 7,000 deaths since 2004. This concern was underscored by the attempted assassination of Prachachart MP Kamolsak Leewamae on March 20 in Narathiwat, which has escalated into a major political and security crisis. A former marine officer has been detained, and investigations are probing claims of military-linked vehicle use.

- Security Incidents and Threats - Krabi Airport Bomb Scare

On April 26, a passenger's "bomb" remark caused panic and led to the evacuation and a full security sweep of a flight at Krabi International Airport. The 45-year-old male passenger was subsequently arrested after admitting the claim was a joke. No explosives were found, but the incident caused significant disruption and highlighted airport security protocols.

- Defense Policy and Strategic Shifts - FY2027 Defense Budget Emphasis

Prime Minister Anutin Charnvirakul, speaking on April 20, emphasized the critical importance of strengthening Thailand's defense readiness in the proposed fiscal year 2027 budget of 3.788 trillion baht. He stressed that military capability must be sufficient to deter potential external threats amidst rising global instability, ensuring the nation's sovereignty and dignity.

- Cybersecurity - International Cooperation

Thailand actively engaged in cybersecurity discussions, agreeing with China on April 24 to strengthen collaboration against transnational crime and cybercams. Similarly, on April 27, Thailand and Singapore committed to enhanced cybersecurity cooperation, particularly concerning critical underwater infrastructure. These efforts align with Thailand's earlier proposal to host an international summit on combating cybercrime.

## Geopolitical Impact and Regional Dynamics

Thailand's recent security developments underscore its proactive stance in navigating a complex geopolitical landscape, particularly within Southeast Asia and with major global powers. The decision to revoke MOU 44 with Cambodia, while potentially increasing short-term bilateral tensions over maritime claims, signals Thailand's intent to assert its national interests under international legal frameworks like UNCLOS. This

move, coupled with the initiation of border fence projects along both the Cambodian and Malaysian frontiers, reflects a broader strategy to enhance border security and control against illicit activities, which could have implications for regional cooperation and cross-border trade if not managed carefully.

The high-level diplomatic engagements with China, including Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi's visit on April 24, highlight Thailand's continued balancing act between major powers. The agreement to strengthen strategic alignment and combat transnational crime and cyberscams with China demonstrates a pragmatic approach to shared security concerns. China's offer to mediate the Thailand-Cambodia border conflict further positions Beijing as a significant regional player. Simultaneously, the deepening defense ties with Singapore, focusing on military training, defense industry development, and critical underwater infrastructure protection, reinforce Thailand's commitment to ASEAN-centric security cooperation and its efforts to diversify partnerships.

Thailand's vocal concerns at the UN Security Council regarding the Strait of Hormuz underscore its vulnerability to external maritime security disruptions, particularly given its reliance on these routes for energy imports. This highlights Thailand's broader interest in maintaining freedom of navigation and regional stability, extending its diplomatic reach beyond immediate Southeast Asian concerns. The ongoing internal conflict in the southern provinces, however, remains a persistent challenge that could draw international attention and potentially complicate diplomatic narratives if not effectively addressed.

## Military and Defense Analysis

Thailand's military and defense posture during this period reflects a clear commitment to modernization and enhanced readiness. The Royal Thai Navy's introduction of new amphibious 8x8 armored vehicles, with a significant domestic component, demonstrates a focus on both capability enhancement for border security and the development of its indigenous defense industry. This aligns with the broader defense industry development policy and plans for future capability expansion. The ongoing frigate procurement project, with six international bidders, further illustrates the Navy's drive to bolster its maritime security capabilities and safeguard crucial sea routes, a critical aspect given Thailand's extensive coastline and strategic maritime interests.

Prime Minister Anutin Charnvirakul's emphasis on strengthening defense readiness in the fiscal year 2027 budget, with a proposed 3.788 trillion baht, signals a sustained commitment to defense spending. This budgetary focus aims to ensure military equipment is fully prepared and capable of deterring potential external threats,

reflecting a strategic adaptation to a volatile global environment. While the major multinational exercise Cobra Gold 2026 concluded in March, its inclusion of cyber and space domains in training highlights Thailand's recognition of modern, multi-domain warfare and its efforts to integrate advanced technologies into its defense strategy, often in cooperation with allies like the US. The criticism regarding the military-led approach in the southern provinces, however, suggests an area where defense strategy might need re-evaluation to achieve long-term stability through more comprehensive, peace-focused frameworks.

## Outlook and Forecast

**Short-term trends (1-3 months):** In the immediate future, Thailand is likely to continue its diplomatic efforts to manage the fallout from the revocation of MOU 44 with Cambodia. Negotiations under UNCLOS will likely commence, requiring careful diplomatic handling to prevent escalation of tensions. The border fence projects with Cambodia and Malaysia will likely proceed, potentially leading to increased security presence and localized impacts on cross-border movements. We can expect continued vigilance along the Thai-Myanmar border, especially in Mae Hong Son, given the ongoing conflict in Myanmar. Defense acquisition processes, particularly for the frigates, will move into the detailed review phase. Cybersecurity cooperation with China and Singapore will likely see initial implementation steps, focusing on information sharing and joint initiatives against cybercrime and critical infrastructure protection.

**Critical flashpoints and risk areas:** The Thai-Cambodian maritime border remains a critical flashpoint, with the termination of MOU 44 potentially leading to renewed diplomatic friction and increased rhetoric. The Thai-Myanmar land border, particularly in provinces like Mae Hong Son, is at high risk of spillover violence from the Myanmar conflict, including stray ordnance and refugee flows. The southern border provinces (Pattani, Yala, Narathiwat) will continue to be a hotspot for insurgency, with the potential for further high-profile security incidents and continued debate over the effectiveness of the current military-led approach. While localized, incidents like the Krabi Airport bomb scare highlight the persistent threat of disruptive security incidents, even if not directly linked to terrorism.

**Indicators to monitor:** Key indicators to monitor include the progress and tone of Thailand-Cambodia maritime negotiations, any further cross-border incidents along the Thai-Myanmar frontier, and the effectiveness of new border security measures. Domestically, the frequency and severity of incidents in the southern provinces, as well as public and political discourse surrounding the government's strategy there, will be crucial. The pace of defense modernization programs and the outcomes of international defense cooperation initiatives will also indicate Thailand's evolving

security posture. Furthermore, the implementation of cybersecurity agreements and the success in combating transnational cybercrime will be important.

Strategic recommendations: Thailand should prioritize robust diplomatic engagement with Cambodia to ensure a smooth transition to UNCLOS-based maritime negotiations, potentially leveraging regional partners like China or ASEAN for mediation. Along the Myanmar border, a comprehensive humanitarian and security response plan is essential, including enhanced early warning systems and contingency plans for civilian protection. In the southern provinces, a re-evaluation of the security strategy towards a more inclusive, peace-focused framework, as suggested by critics, could be beneficial, alongside continued efforts to address socio-economic grievances. Continued investment in cybersecurity capabilities and international cooperation is vital to protect critical infrastructure and combat evolving digital threats. Finally, maintaining a balanced foreign policy that diversifies security partnerships while upholding national interests will be crucial for navigating regional and global geopolitical complexities.
